# **Bowling 2019**

# 1. **Eligibility:**

All schools must be members of the ECADA in good standing to be eligible to enter the **2019 Bowling** tournament. A winning record is not required for entry. The tournament shall be played on the following dates:

**Team Championship:** Monday, February 4, 2019 at 1:30 PM at Eagle Rock Lanes, 424 Eagle Rock Avenue, West Orange. (973) 731-6363. (Snow date 2/5)

**Individual Championship:** Thursday, February 7, 2019 at 3 PM at Eagle Rock Lanes, 424 Eagle Rock Avenue, West Orange. (973) 731-6363. The top 12 scorers from Monday's Team Championships are eligible to compete for the Individual Championship. (Snow date 2/8)

**Postponement** shall be at the discretion of the tournament director. The Tournament Director shall oversee the rescheduling of the tournament and has the right to reschedule.

## 2. Entry Fee

The entry fee for the tournament is \$105.00 per team. Schools not having a team may enter individuals at a cost of \$25 each (see #8). Please make the check payable to the Super Essex Conference and mail to:

# 4. Entry Procedure

Entry into the 2019 ECADA Bowling Tournament must be submitted online through the Super Essex Conference website, <u>www.sec.powermediallc.org</u> no later than noon on <u>Tuesday</u>, **January 29, 2019**.

# 5. Entry Form Signatures

The "Tournament Information & Statement of Agreement" form <u>must be signed and</u> <u>submitted</u> by <u>the athletic director</u>, <u>and the school principal</u>. The signatures indicate the school's agreement, awareness and compliance with all rules and regulations governing the 2019 Essex County Bowling Tournament.

#### 6. **Deadlines**

Please adhere to all the tournament deadlines.

## 7. **Proper completion of Entry Forms**

Properly complete all required entry forms and adhere to the instructions on each form or the instruction within the aforementioned rules and regulations.

#### 8. Individual Entries

Schools that do not have an interscholastic bowling team may enter individuals providing they meet all NJSIAA criteria for athletic eligibility. These individuals will bowl on **Monday**, **February 4**<sup>th</sup> at the Team Championships in order to qualify for the **Individual Championship**. Schools must submit an entry on the SEC website and must have an adult school representative in attendance with the bowlers for the duration of the competition.

**ECADA ENTRY FEE SCHEDULE:** For schools competing on an interscholastic basis:

Girls Team - \$105; Boys Team - \$105

For schools not competing on an interscholastic basis:

**\$25** Per Individual entered, maximum of 4 per gender, capped at **\$100** in each division. (Sample - A school that enters 2 Girls and 3 Boys would pay **\$50** In the Girls Division, and would pay **\$75** In the Boys Division.)

**TOURNAMENT - FEBRUARY 4, 2019** 

Listed below are the criteria of rules and regulations that shall govern the tournament. These rules are based on the United State Bowling Congress (USBC).

The team tournament is set for Monday, February 4, 2019 at 1:30 PM at Eagle Rock Lanes, 424 Eagle Rock Avenue, West Orange. (973) 731-6363.

The Top 12 scorers of Monday's team championship are eligible to compete for the Individual Championship on Thursday, February 7, 2019 at 3 PM at Eagle Rock Lanes. They will bowl 3 games after which the top 5 scorers will advance by step-ladder to an overall champion. There will be a boys and a girls champion if a sufficient number of girls' teams enter the tournament.

Entry into the 2019 ECADA Bowling Tournament must be submitted online through the Super Essex Conference website, <a href="www.sec.powermediallc.org">www.sec.powermediallc.org</a> no later than noon on Tuesday, January 29, 2019.

Team Championship Awards for the team scoring the highest total scratch wood in the tournament will be the winners.

There will be Individual Championship Awards

### **Rules:**

- a} List your 5 bowlers and your substitutes (subs). You may list a maximum of 5 subs.
- b} Each team should arrive 30-45 minutes before the starting time.
- c} Subs are permitted to bowl at anytime as per NJSIAA rules.
- d} If a bowler is late and the game has started, the bowler will receive a zero (0) for each frame that is already completed. Scoring will begin at that point he/she begins.
- f} Each team is bowling scratch, no handicap will be given.
- g} The team captain or coach is to report to the tournament director for your lane assignments.
- h} Lane assignments will be picked at random on a first come basis.
- i} All rules apply to N.J.S.I.A.A.
- j} Tournament Officials or Coaches will record games on triplicate sheets. No bowler is allowed to touch score sheets. Automatic machines will be used for scoring. Any problems should be directed to the Tournament Chairperson or Tournament Director.

Entry fee will be \$105.00 per school team, \$25.00 per individual not competing with a team. This fee also includes the bowling lineage and the rental fee for bowling shoes.
