2018 Golf

1. **Eligibility:**

All schools must be members of the ECADA in good standing to be eligible to enter the **2018 Golf Tournament**. The tournament will be played on the following dates:

Championship: Wednesday, April 18, 2018 at 8:00 AM, Weequahic Park Golf Course, 1 Thomas Carmichael Drive, Newark.
Rain date is Tuesday, May 1st.

The Tournament Director shall oversee the rescheduling of the tournament and has the right to reschedule and to establish pairings in the best interest of the tournament. Tournament takes precedence over conference and independent contests.

2. **Entry Fee**

The entry fee for the tournament is \$105.00 per team. Schools that do not have a golf team may enter an individual. You must provide a "ranking score" for said individual and full day supervision. Fee for an individual is \$40.00. Individuals will not displace other's scores. Please make the check payable to the **Super Essex Conference** and mail to

4. **Entry Procedure**

Entry materials must be submitted online through the Super Essex Conference website, www.sec.powermediallc.org no later than noon on **April 16, 2018**.

5. **Awards**
First, second and third place teams will receive trophies, the winning team will receive six (6) individual awards and awards will be given for individual low gross 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

6. **Entry Form Signatures**
The “Tournament Information & Statement of Agreement” form **must be signed by the Head Coach, the Athletic Director and the School Principal prior to the start of the tournament.** The signatures indicate the school’s agreement, awareness and compliance with all rules and regulations governing **2018 ECT Golf Tournament.**

7. **Establishing Pairings**
Tournament Directors retain the right to establish pairings in the best interest of the tournament and to start play when most advantageous.

8. **Deadlines**
Please adhere to all the tournament deadlines.

9. **Proper completion of Entry Forms**
Properly complete all required entry forms and adhere to the instructions on each form or the instruction within the aforementioned tournament rules and regulations.

10. **Retain Last Two Pages and Bring Them to Tournament for Reference**
Retain the Information List and Coaches’ Responsibilities pages at the back of the entry and bring both pages to the tournament for reference. This is important.

11. **Individual Entries**
Only schools that do not have a golf team may enter an individual. Individual will not displace any scorers and be eligible for any medals. Entry must include information on individual’s scoring and schools must provide full day supervision.

The tournament will be held at Weequahic Park Golf Course, Newark, on April 18, 2018 with a rain date of May 1st. Sign in time is 7:30 AM. Your entry must be completed online, on the SEC website, no later than noon on Monday, April 16th.

In the past, the ECT's Golf tournament has been well represented with many teams competing in this annual event. A firm line-up is not needed at this time, but your commitment to compete is necessary.

It is extremely important for you to retain this form and bring it to the tournament with you.

Tee-off time:	Immediately following coaches meeting.
Rules of play:	USGA – local course rules

Tournament Rules, Regulations and Format:

1. 18 hole stroke play
2. Five (5) man teams (do not bring more than five (5))
3. Four (4) best scores.
4. Ties for first place – extra holes will be played.
5. All other ties – match of cards from first hole.
6. Schools that do not have a golf team may enter an individual. Schools must provide individual's score and full day supervision. Individuals will not displace other's scores.
7. Coaches must accompany teams.
8. Proper attire must be worn – no jeans or shorts – shirts must have collars.
9. No caddies or pull-carts.
10. No smoking or alcohol beverages, etc.
11. **All** members of threesome/foursome/fivesome **must** sign cards.
12. Proper golf etiquette should be displayed at all times.
13. Tournament Director has right to establish playing groups and start time so as to benefit play.

ECT 2018 GOLF TOURNAMENT COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES LIST

1. Coaches will be assigned a foursome/threesome to supervise. Therefore, leave your clubs at home.
2. Coaches will be responsible for accurate scores and rulings.
3. All score cards must be signed by all players and coaches.
4. Coaches will submit and read scorecards to the person posting scores.
5. Any rulings that need to be addressed by the tournament director will be reviewed by the tournament committee (TBD).
6. All players will play their ball “through the green” with “all” putts holed out. Any deviation will constitute a disqualification of that player.
7. Weather conditions and local course rules will determine rules of play; i.e., summer/winter.

Winter Rules

- Plugged balls – inbounds – no penalty
- Plugged balls – out of bounds or in woods – penalty (i.e., lost ball = stroke and distance)
- Lift, clean and place in own fairway

Summer Rules

- Do not touch ball until “on the green”
 - Winter/summer rules: When on the green do not change ball for putting purpose.
8. Interior “out-of-bounds stakes” do not apply.
 9. All coaches must make every effort to keep their group moving at a reasonable pace.
 10. Proper golf etiquette must be displayed at all times.
