Boys Soccer, 2021

1. **Eligibility:**

All schools must be members of the ECADC in good standing to be eligible to enter the **2021 Boys Soccer Tournament**. The tournament is a single elimination tournament played on the following dates:

Preliminary Rounds (If necessary) Games must be played on or before **Saturday, October 2** if a 1st Preliminary is needed, and on or by **Tuesday, October 5** if a 2nd preliminary is needed. If schools cannot agree on a mutual date for preliminary games, then Oct 2 and Oct 5 are the mandatory dates. Rain date is next available day.

First Round On or by **Thursday, October 7**, at the higher seeded team's home field. Rain date is next available day.

Quarter Finals: **Saturday, October 9**, with a 2:00pm recommended start, at the higher seeded team's home field. Rain date is next available day.

Semi Finals: **Tuesday, October 12**, at Caldwell High School. (Lower half of bracket at 5pm, Upper half of bracket at 7pm). Rain date is next available day.

Finals: **Saturday, October 16, 5:00pm** at Belleville High School. (Doubleheader with girls).

Postponed games shall be rescheduled on the following day if conditions are acceptable. The tournament director shall oversee the rescheduling of games and has the right to reschedule in order to prevent a deleterious scheduling situation for schools involved. Tournament contests take precedence over conference and independent contests. If a higher seeded team's field remains unplayable, the game will either be moved to a neutral site or to the lower seeded team's site if that field is playable and in better condition than the higher seeded team's site.

2. **Entry Fee**

The entry fee for the tournament is \$105.00. Please make the check payable to the “Super Essex Conference”. Send entry to;

4. **Entry Procedure**

Entry into the 2021 Essex County Boys Soccer Tournament must be submitted online through the Super Essex Conference website, www.sec.powermediallc.org, no later than noon on Tuesday, September 28, 2021.

In order to ensure that sufficient recording of game results be documented for seeding purposes, the online entry may only be submitted between Saturday morning September 25th until noon on Tuesday, September 28th.

Results of any games, which are played after the entry is submitted, must be phoned, e-mailed, or verbally transmitted to the tournament directors by the start of the seeding committee meeting.

5. **Seeding**

The tournament will be seeded by committee on **Wednesday, September 29, 2021** at 7:00 PM. at Montclair Kimberley Academy Upper School. Only the members of the seeding committee, the tournament directors are permitted to attend the seeding meeting. **Athletic Directors will be called regarding their seeds and their opening round opponents. Seeding criteria will be based on, but not limited to; records, strengths of schedules, head-to-head competition, common opponents and judgment.**

6. **Officials**

All officials will be assigned by the SEC soccer assignor. The higher seeded team is responsible for paying the officials with the exception of the semifinals and finals. The ECADC shall pay the officials at the semifinals and championship final. The fee for all officials is \$85.00 per game up to the semifinals. The semifinals rate will be \$87.00 and \$90.00 for the finals.

7. **Balls**

Each team shall provide three (3) National Federation approved game balls. The officials shall determine which balls are used.

8. **Ball Persons**

Each team will provide at least one (1) ball person to run the sidelines with a ball in order to keep the game moving.

9. **Tie Breaker Rule**

The following tie breaker rule shall be implemented:

If the game is still tied after the regulation game and 2 ten minute “sudden victory” overtime periods have been played, penalty kicks will be used as a tie breaker. **This procedure shall be utilized for all rounds including the championship final.**

I.

- a. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken
- b. Each coach will select five (5) players, on or off the field (except those who may have been disqualified), to take the kicks.
- c. A coin toss shall be held. The team winning the toss shall have choice of kicking first or second.
- d. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow –up on the kick.
- e. The defending team may change the goalkeeper prior to each kick.

II.

If the score remains tied after each team has taken five (5) kicks:

Each coach will select any five (5) players, whether or not a player participated in the initial five (5) kicks, to take another set of five (5) kicks in a sudden victory situation, wherein if one team scores and the other team does not score, the game is ended without more kicks being taken.

This procedure shall be repeated until a winner is determined.

10. **Admission**

Admission for the semifinals and finals will be \$5.00 general admission and \$2.00 senior citizens and students.

11. **Automated External Defibrillator.**

Pursuant to NJ state law, Janet’s Law, schools hosting any ECT game, match or contest must provide an AED on site. For events held at predetermined neutral sites all contestants must bring and have available for immediate need an AED for their team

12. **Statement of Agreement.**

The “**Tournament Information & Statement of Agreement**” form **must be signed and submitted by the athletic director, and the school principal.** The signatures indicate the school’s agreement, awareness and compliance with all rules and regulations governing the **2021 Essex County Boys Soccer Tournament.**

13. **Deadlines**

Please adhere to all the tournament deadlines.

14. **Proper Completion of Entry Forms**

Properly complete all required entry forms and adhere to the instructions on each form **and** the instructions within the aforementioned tournament rules and regulations.
