Selection of All-Conference Teams - All-Conference Teams will be selected in each division in the following format: (Revised April 2, 2013)

In an effort to recognize the significant strength of the American and Liberty Divisions in sports that have three (3) or more divisions, additional awards have been added to existing policies to establish the following:

- American Division First Team Only – maximum 4 infielders, 3 outfielders, 1 pitcher, 1 catcher and 4 open selections - maximum 2 Honorable Mention/school (Second Team has 3 open selections)
- Liberty Division – maximum 4 infielders, 3 outfielders, 1 pitcher, 1 catcher and 3 open selections - maximum 2 Honorable Mention/school
- All other divisions = Same positions plus 3 open selections and one Honorable Mention/school

Colonial/Independence/Freedom Divisions – If there are five (5) or fewer teams in a division, the number of awards will be the starting team number with no open positions. Honorable mention will remain at one.
